

Section Z (Linguistics and Language Science) of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) is pleased to offer a small number of awards to cover [the meeting registration fees](#) for the [AAAS 2017 Annual Meeting](#) for qualified undergraduates, graduate students, and postdocs. Presentation at the meeting is not a requirement for this award, though students are encouraged to consider submitting abstracts to [the student poster session](#) (deadline for poster submission: October 20). Travel and accommodation expenses are not included in the award. Undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled in a degree program in Linguistics or allied field, and postdocs in Linguistics or allied field are eligible to apply.

Applications should include the name, class rank or post-doc status, institutional affiliation and email contact of the applicant, along with a brief statement of research interest (max. 1 page); applicants who submit a poster abstract should include the poster title in their applications. Applications should be sent via email to the Section Z Steering Group at [wasow@stanford.edu](mailto:wasow@stanford.edu) no later than November 15. Verification of student or post-doc status must be sent to the same address in a separate email from the applicant's faculty advisor or supervisor.
