




DATA SOUP!

- Conference data...





An Impact Factor IS: A journal level metric: normalizes citation count by the amount of scholarly citable content

An Impact Factor is **NOT**: An article level metric.

Individual article citation counts vary greatly even within a single volume and year



Impact Factor (IF)—SNAPSHOT OF A 3 YR WINDOW






