



In response to events in Charlottesville, VA and elsewhere, the LSA has issued the following [statement](#), adopted by the Executive Committee on Aug. 25, 2017.


Linguists Sought as Reviewers for NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP) Panels

The National Science Foundation (NSF) is seeking GRFP panels composed of researchers and educators, including linguists, from a wide range of institutions, geographic locations, and disciplinary and interdisciplinary backgrounds. All selected panelists must attend one of several available orientation session webinars in November 2017; review approximately 30 graduate-school like applications over about 4 weeks beginning in early December; and participate in two panel sessions online in January 2018 to discuss the applications reviewed. No travel is required; the process is entirely virtual.
